■ COVERAGE

General liability for on- and off-campus third-party claims for bodily injury or property damage occurring during an approved event or activity, subject to certain limitations — including the exclusion of abuse or molestation claims.

■ EXCLUDED ACTIVITIES / EVENTS *

- Aircraft events
- Animal acts & shows
- Animals non-performing
- Any event with known attendance over 5,000 people
- Any activity held at a private residence
- Athletic or sports participants
- Bicycling on public streets & racing events
- Boat shows
- Bounce houses & inflatables
- Bungee jumping
- Carnivals with mechanical amusement devices
- Circuses (except a field trip or fundraiser at a circus not arranged by the booster)
- Climbing walls
- Concerts – heavy metal, hip hop, or rap

General Liability

\$1,000,000 per occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate

Liquor Liability

\$1,000,000 per occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate

■ MEMBER BENEFITS

The District is automatically listed as Additional Insured on the policy.

■ ENROLLMENT

Each Foundation must complete the ASCIP-B Roster Form and submit to ASCIP annually.
