SEIS has released updated features and enhancements for the new year

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

To enhance student data security, SEIS will be implementing mandatory Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) will be required for all districts starting Monday, September 29.

Users will receive a verification code via email when logging in.

Please be sure to verify all email addresses on SEIS user accounts. If a user has an incorrect email address, they will not receive the verification email.

We strongly recommend enabling MFA before the mandatory deadline to prevent any potential work stoppages leading into Fall 1, in case complications arise. The MFA materials can be downloaded here.

RETIRED SERVICE AND SERVICE LOCATION CODES

As of July 1, the following codes will be retired from CALPADS and SEIS:

Service Location

 570 - Charter Schools. 510 - Regular classroom/public day school is the appropriate code for Charter Schools going forward, this will apply to LEAs adopting students from Charter LEAs

Services

- 350 Individual and Small Group Instruction
- 540 Day Treatment Services

Starting July 1, these codes will cause errors for IEPs dated after June 30 and must be updated.

Bulk Updating Student Grade Levels

Bulk Updating: Date Student Enrolled in District/LEA

The "Date Student Enrolled in District/LEA" field (located on the CALPADS Student page of the SEIS Student record) should match the date entered in the Student Information System, also reported in the SENR File submitted to CALPADS for the **current academic year.**

SELPA Monitoring reports 16.21 & 16.25

As enrollments are reported, run the 16.21 report to identify any unidentified Special Education (SPED) students and run the 16.25 report to check for pending meetings.

Please ensure all transfer-out requests are completed within 48 hours of receipt.




Review Caseloads for accuracy

At the start of this school year, it is crucial for providers and case managers to review their caseload for accuracy. If you identify any issues, please watch these video tutorials:

Using the IEP Dates report found in the Students Tab, you can sort your student records by the Date of Next Meeting to calendar meetings for the academic year.

Once Caseload is verified LEAs serving TK, K it is recommended to run the **SEIS Search**: **Program Setting (5-22) - PLAN0619F1/PLAN0389F1** to verify that 5 year olds and older have the correct program setting and Gen Ed participation selected.

Once (not before) a 4-year-old TK-K student turns 5 the student's program setting must be updated to a Program Setting (TK-Kgn or greater, ages 5-22) and the Gen Ed Participation Percentage populated.
