Students shared Ori is blocked for some students. -SSC discussed thai was the first year the school implemented the Tier 1 Signs of Suicide (SOS) prevention program. Students shared Signs of Suicide program was helpful. -Students shared that audiences at the college speech classes are ok for some speeches, but would prefer no audience for other speeches</p>
