



HOW TO PURCHASE A senior ad

1. Scan the QR code
2. Select “continue”
3. Click “yearbook ads” in the top right corner and then “Buy a Yearbook Ad”
4. From there, you can select “half page color” or “quarter page color”
5. Select “Student / teacher”
6. Enter the student's first and last name
7. Select “find name.”
8. Select “ok” and then “next.”
9. Create an account or sign in
10. Start designing your senior ad!
