- > Academic Programs

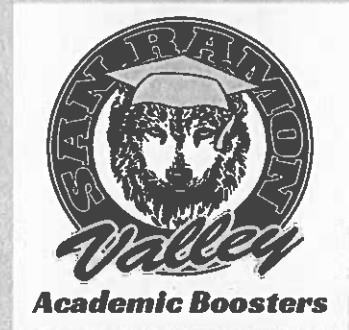
