| ORGANIZED MEDICAL STAFF POLICIES & PROCEDURES | |

POLICY:

The policy will serve as a process for the Medical Staff Executive Committee (MEC) at St. Elizabeth Community Hospital (SECH) to fund, review applications and award scholarships to a senior attending one of the three Tehama County High Schools; Red Bluff High School, Corning High School or Los Molinos High School.

This scholarship is to be awarded to a worthy recipient who will pursue a course of study at a Medical or Osteopathic school of medicine. The school where such studies are to be pursued shall be accredited. This award will be a one-time amount of \$1,000.00.

The scholarship shall be available to all qualified applicants regardless of ethnicity, color, national origin, gender, age or handicapped condition.

PROCEDURE:

1. All students applying for this scholarship must complete the *St. Elizabeth Community Hospital Medical Staff Scholarship Application* located on the school’s website.
2. All students must provide a personal statement, long-term plans and goals, achievements in education, and any obstacles or problems that have had to be overcome so far in life.
3. The High School’s Coordinator of Scholarship Programs will filter out the most appropriate applicants based on the Medical Staff’s criteria. Coordinator will send applications to the Medical Staff Services Department at St. Elizabeth Community Hospital, 2550 Sister Mary Columba Drive, Red Bluff, CA 96080.
4. Applications will be reviewed by a minimum of two members of the MEC in April and a selection made.
5. The represented school coordinator will be notified of the applicant to be awarded this scholarship and provided with the \$1,000.00 check from the Medical Staff at the school’s awards presentation.

Applicant Criteria:

1. Applicants must be a current member of the graduating class at Red Bluff High School, Corning High School or Los Molinos High School with a minimum GPA of 3.5.
2. Applicants must plan on pursuing a course of study leading to a degree from a Medical or Osteopathic school of medicine.
3. A *St. Elizabeth Community Hospital Medical Staff Scholarship Application* and *Personal Statement* must be completed.

School Timeline:

- January- Scholarship Application becomes available for seniors
- March- School Scholarship Committees meets to prescreen applications.
- End of March- Applications of the those who meet criteria are sent to SECH.
- End of April- Schools are notified of recipient
- Mid-May-Senior Award presentation (donors are welcome to present the award to their selected student).
