What Colleges Look For

When college admissions committees sit down to make decision, they usually review 5 aspects of the applicant's folder. Here's what they look for:

- ► An ambitious transcript and good grades.
- ► SAT/ACT scores within the college's mid-50% range.
- ► Extracurricular Achievement-Commitment & accomplishment
- ▶ Interesting, well-written essays. Edit for grammatical errors.
- ▶ Detailed, enthusiastic recommendations from teachers, coaches, counselors, and bosses. Colleges want to know how you think, how you spend time (by choice or necessity) and what you bring to a classroom or extracurricular group.
