

Measure A: Maintaining High-Quality Education with Safe, Modern Schools

Bonita Unified School District (BUSD) is a top-performing K–12 district with state and national recognition for academic achievement and early literacy, preparing students for success in college, careers, and beyond.

Our San Dimas and La Verne Schools

While all our schools are well maintained, they were built more than 35 years ago, with some that are 80 to 125 years old. Funding is needed to address the most urgent and basic improvements, such as replacing 40-year-old heating and air conditioning systems, repairing leaky roofs, and upgrading more than 55-year-old plumbing systems.

During the first week of school this year, 11 of the district's 13 air conditioning systems failed, leaving students to have to learn in classroom temperatures in the 80s and 90s.

Locally Controlled Funding for Neighbourhood Schools

The BUSD Board of Education voted unanimously to place Measure A, a local school improvement bond measure, on the June 2026 ballot, to keep students safe and maintain high-quality education.

If approved by local voters, Measure A could provide up to \$256 million in locally controlled funding to update our schools and would be limited to \$59 per \$100,000 of assessed (not market) value annually, for as long as bonds are outstanding.

Fiscal Accountability and Local Control

By law, Measure A would have mandatory strict fiscal accountability, including:

- All funds remain under local control for BUSD schools
- Citizens' oversight committee, independent audits, and annual public reports of all spending to ensure funds are spent as promised
