

2026-2027 AP Exam Registration Information

Dear Advanced Placement Students and Parents/Guardians,

Taking an AP Exam is an important opportunity for students to demonstrate their knowledge and skills in a college-level course. AP Exams are developed and scored by the College Board and provide students with the opportunity to potentially earn college credit, advanced placement, or both, depending on the policies of the college or university they attend. Taking the exam can also provide students with an externally recognized measure of their achievement in an AP course. AP courses are designed to prepare students for the comprehensive AP Exams administered in May 2027. Because AP credit and placement policies vary by institution, students considering specific colleges or universities are encouraged to review each school's AP policies or contact the admissions or academic advising office for the most current information.

AP Exam registration is a two-step process:

1. **Join your AP class section through the College Board.** Your AP teacher will assist you with this process in class.
2. **Register and pay for your AP Exam through Total Registration. Cost = \$110/exam.** This step must be completed independently and is not completed in class. **STUDENTS - Use a personal email address when creating your account, not your CUSD email address. Do not create the account with a parent's email address. You will be prompted to enter a parent's email address once the account is created. This ensures both parties receive communications we send throughout the year.**

Please note, AP Exam registration is a deadline-driven process. It is the responsibility of each student and family to be aware of and meet all required deadlines. We are unable to make exceptions for students who miss registration or payment deadlines. Please carefully review the key dates below and plan accordingly.

September 1 – October 30	Students join their class section in College Board AND Students pay for their exam through Total Registration
October 23	Final day to submit Fee Reduction Eligibility Form AND Late Testing Order Form
October 30	Exam Registration Closes AND Last Day to Request a Full Refund
March 2	Last Day to Request a Partial Refund of \$65 (\$45 cancellation fee)
May 3 – May 14	AP Examinations – Full Exam Schedule

**Exams not paid in full by October 30th will be canceled and an exam will not be ordered, regardless of your exam order status on the College Board's website.*
