

6/25/26 -Food Service Report – Mike Bottarini, Director of Food Services.

This year has been another successful year for the FS Department. We saw an increase in participation by 3000 meals during the year in comparison to 24/25.

We served 258,743 meals

119,047 Breakfast

139,696 Lunches

Summer Program started 6/10/25

We are serving ELOP Summer Camp at Murdock serving Breakfast and Lunch daily and providing a snack in between meals and in the afternoon.

WHS Summer school students are also being offered breakfast and lunch daily and the participation from these students has more than tripled from last year so far.

Every Wednesday we are handing out 7 days of breakfasts and lunches for all pre-registered families in the community via a delivery route and a drive Through station at WHS. It has been another successful start.

Total to date for summer program (6/10 – 6/23) 11,986 meals served in 2 weeks.

If the numbers remain consistent, we will see an increase of approximately 6000 meals in comparison to last summer.

Thank you to the Summer FS team, I appreciate all of your efforts and hard work and I am sure the community does as well. It has been a challenge and you all have done an amazing job.
