HOLIDAYS: All legal school holidays on the school calendar. FRINGE BENEFITS: The district provides Health and Welfare benefits including life / accidental death / dismemberment insurance. The District contribution is capped at \$10,045 per year for full time employees and pro-rated for eligible part time employees. Participating employees must select medical and life/AD&D insurance, with the option to add employee dental and/or vision. Additional dependent coverage may be purchased for the insurance options selected by the employee. Retiring employees have the option of continued enrollment in the District benefit offerings, and the retiree shall pay all premiums and fees required.
