DROP OFF AND PICK UP

A few friendly tips when dropping off and picking up your child from school.

Drop Off:

1. Pull forward as far as possible: Do not stop by the cafeteria to drop your child off. Pull forward all the way to the small playground. Students can walk to the cafeteria. This will ensure that we are not having traffic back up on the street.
2. Do not exit your car. Drivers who are using the "Drop Off" lane, must not get out of their vehicle. If you need to open the door for your child, get their backpack, or exit for any other reason, you must park your car.

Pick Up:

1. Keep the line moving: When picking up, if you do not see your child, circle back around. You may be asked to circle back around if cars behind you need to exit once they have their child.
2. Use crosswalk: Use the crosswalks when walking through the parking lot.

Your child's safety is our number one concern. Thank you for helping us keep them safe by following the drop off/pick up procedures.
