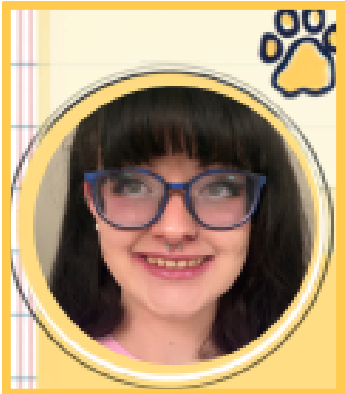




New Teacher Introductions
