

# Pioneer Union Elementary School District

## Transportation Services Plan 2025-26

Per Education Code (EC) Section 39800.1, as a condition of receiving apportionments for Transportation Services (under EC Section 41850.1), a local educational agency shall develop a plan describing the transportation services. The plan shall be presented and adopted by the governing board of the local educational agency on or before **APRIL 1, 2026** in an open meeting with the opportunity for in-person and remote public comment.
