2.1 Superintendent Update – Angela Gouker

- Superintendent Gouker welcomed Colonel Dauer to the board meeting.
- Summer Camp has the highest attendance this year even though the pool was not used.
- The start of school was amazing and inspiring to visit the school sites and see the hard work that the staff put into the day.
- Thank you to the board members for making the time to visit the schools.
- Professional growth opportunity, this week has been a little difficult and would like to thank Chief Garlock and Nicole Newman for their collaboration and diligence to present a united front to protect our staff and students.
- Thank you to the staff for professionalism and stewardship in providing a safe campus for our students. Everyone has rallied together to set a safe tone.

2.2 [Enrollment Report](#) – Angela Gouker

- District wide we are up 14 students
- Bear River is 3 students, short of 600
- Preschool is up one and remain with small class sizes due to age requirements
- WSD will file J-13A, this is the Request for Allowance of Attendance Due to Emergency Conditions for attendance recovery.
- Superintendent Gouker explained the new state mandates regarding independent study and reassured that the absences due to the threats will be excused.

2.3 CBO Report – Ana Azcona DeJesus

- CBO Ana DeJesus reported new staff are working well and that things are running smoothly.
- The district office had a Professional Development training this month on “To Gift or Not to Gift”. I was a refresher on spending public funds and what to spend money on.
- Upcoming training will be on account codes.
- WSD had an audit last month. The audit went well and we will be continuing to work on internal controls.
