In the 2025-26 school year, Come Back Butte Charter spent \$12,813.87 of its remaining \$13,100 23/24 annual allocation from Proposition 28 funds. Funds were spent on a teaching artist, supplemental art textbooks, and supplies for the students to attend monthly craft sessions. The school counselor will also be organizing an art show with the students, as well as working with them to make digital art on ipads. 100% of the \$13,560 24/25 allocation and \$19,043 25/26 allocation, will be rolled over into the 2026-27 school year. Given that Comeback's enrollment is under 500 students, the requirement to spend 80% of the funds on certificated staff does not apply.
