"Fall Back" - Turn your clocks back 1 hour Saturday night, November 1st.





**Volunteer Clearance - Reminder - NEW REQUIREMENTS** 

We ask all of our parents/guardians to register w/ Be A Mentor for level #1-general volunteer. This clearance will allow you to be on campus and/or in the classroom with the children. The Fun Run is a little over a week away, taking place on November 6th! Make sure you complete all steps below so your student can participate.


All students must have a Pledgestar account and a completed online waiver to participate. Follow ALL steps below:

#### Can my child purchase a second meal?

Yes, but they need to have funds on their prepayment account, which can be done on the Titan Family Portal. Cash will not be accepted in the breakfast or lunch line. Cash or checks can be given to the Child Nutrition Manager outside of the breakfast or lunch meal service time. A second breakfast is \$4.00 and a second lunch is \$5.75 at Elementary Schools and \$6.00 at Middle and High Schools. School staff can purchase a breakfast for \$4.50 and lunch for \$6.00.
