

Parents are asked to enforce the dress code standards before their child leaves for school in the morning. This will allow the school to fully concentrate on the academic learning process of all students in attendance.

These standards are a result of working with parents, teachers, yard personnel, and the administration of the Evergreen Union School District.

- Clothing must be suitable for all scheduled classroom activities, including physical education, science labs, field trips, and other activities where unique hazards or specialized attire or safety gear is required.
- Attire and/or grooming depicting or advocating violence, weapons, criminal activity, gang-related activity, use of tobacco, alcohol or drugs, pornography, foul language, hate speech, or clothing that could be considered dangerous or that could be used as a weapons are prohibited.
- Hats/caps must be worn facing forward and cannot be worn inside any building (learning environments).
- Shorts must have a 3" inseam.
- No torn or ripped jeans above the 3" inseam.
- When the body is standing straight, clothing must cover the chest, back, torso, stomach,

and lower extremities from armpit to armpit to mid-thigh.

- Tops must have a strap.
- Undergarments are not to be exposed at any time.
- Students must wear shoes at all times. Shoes must have a heel strap, be secured to their feet and not pose a safety risk. Students cannot wear: flip flops, slides, slippers, or shoes with wheels.

\*Students shall not be prohibited from dressing in a manner consistent with their gender identity or gender expression or with their religious or cultural observance as long as it aligns with the above principles
