

ORINDA USD MEASURE A & B LOW-INCOME SENIOR PARCEL TAX EXEMPTION

Orinda voters have approved two parcel taxes: JI (2003): \$385.00; H3 (2009): \$124.00.

Both tax measures authorize the district to provide exemptions for "Low-Income Senior Citizens".

The **Application** covers exemptions for both taxes.

Exemption Eligibility Criteria:

- At least one household member who owns and occupies the property must be 65 years or older.
- The total adjusted gross income of <u>all</u> persons living in the household must not exceed 50% of the median income for Contra Costa County

Parcel Tax Resolution

"Low-Income Senior Citizen Exemption. In order to provide tax relief to those members of the Orinda community most in need, any parcel owned and occupied by a low-income person 65 years of age or older shall be exempt from the Excellence in Education Tax upon proper application to the District. The exemption shall be available pursuant to procedures to be prescribed by the Board of Trustees or otherwise as required by law or by the Contra Costa County Tax Collector. A "low-income person" is a member of a "very low income household" as defined by California Health and Safety Code Section 50105. Under current law, this means any household whose income does not exceed 50 percent of the area median income, adjusted for family size and revised annually."

• If you are approved, the exemption will continue each year as long as the property is owned by you and remains your primary residence.

Application Process:

- 1. Complete all parts of the application form; Application deadline on or before JUNE 2, 2026
- 2. Applicant must sign the completed application form
- 3. Attach required documentation to the application form
 - Copy of Federal tax return for 2025: For each member of household, Adjusted Gross Income of Form 1040, or Form 1040-SR, or Form 1040-ES
 - Recent Utility Bill: PG&E, water, sewer, telephone, or garbage bill
 - **Proof of Age:** Copy of California driver's license, <u>or</u> copy of birth certificate, <u>or</u> copy of another federal/state identification card
 - Copy of 2024-25 property tax bill for parcel for which the exemption is requested
