# Art Awards and Lettering Policy

### Type of Awards:

- 1. Jacket A student meeting all lettering requirements the first time earns a letter jacket. A student only earns one jacket from his/her school during their career.
- 2. Letter A student meeting the lettering requirements for the first time and already has a letter jacket earns a letter.
- 3. Metal Bar Insert A student meeting the lettering requirement for the second, third, and fourth time earns a metal bar.

#### **Criteria for Student Awards**

- 1. Initial lettering requirement is the accumulation of 20 points (may be over multiple years). Succeeding lettering requirement is the accumulation of 10 points within a year.
  - a. Local or City Contests 5 points for winning, 2 points for placing
  - b. District Show

Night Gallery - Teachers Choice 3 points, Frame Up 2 points, Selected to Exhibit 1 point

Memorial Scholarship – Winner & Runner Up 4 points

<u>TASB/TASA</u> – Selection for Show 4 points, Selected from district 2 points <u>YAM</u> – Governor's Gallery 8 points, Flag Winner 8 points, Capital Exhibit 4 points, Selected from district 2 points

National Portfolio Day - 2 points

#### c. Regional & State Contests

<u>Scholastic</u> – National Gold Key 10 points, National Silver Key 8 points, Regional Gold Key 4 points, Regional Silver Key 2 points

<u>Western Art</u> – Best of Show or Reserve Champion 10 points, Top 25 6 points, Top 50 4 points, 2 points for placing

<u>VASE</u> – Gold Seal 10 points, State Rating IV 4 points, State Advancing 4 points, Regional Rating IV 4 points

Battle of Flowers – Cover Design Winner 8 points, 4 points for placing & merit

#### d. Other District Honors

NAHS – President 2 points, Officer 1 point

AP Portfolio or Art History - Passing Score 2 points
