Meeting agenda Purpose:

- **Focusing Direction** – Clarify purpose, goals, success criteria; share data tied to priority problems (replaces “Information Sharing” when it’s connected to goals).
- **Cultivating Collaborative Cultures** – Build relationships, norms, and role clarity for joint work (refines “Relationship Building” beyond icebreakers).
- **Deepening Learning** – Capacity building, shared sensemaking, root-cause analysis, practice-sharing (reframes “Learning” toward improvement work, not just PD).
- **Securing Accountability** – Planning, problem-solving, decisions, owners, timelines, measures (combines “Planning,” “Problem-Solving,” and “Decision Making” into action + monitoring).
