NEISD began a recycling program in the campus cafeterias and kitchens at the beginning of the 2009-2010 school year. The recycling program has reduced our garbage volume and has kept several tons of recyclable materials from going into landfills. Each campus has organized and developed the cafeteria recycling program to best meet their needs.

Recyclable items from the cafeteria include: plastic milk bottles, individual black plastic serving bowls, salad trays, plastic water bottles, and plastic cereal bowls. Students can also recycle items that they have brought from home such as aluminum cans, individually packed plastic fruit cups, Lunchable containers, and most other paper-based or plastic items. Our kitchen employees recycle large boxes, steel cans, and plastic food containers that. Sometimes the recycling bins will be full long before the garbage bins fill up!
