

Blackbrook Audubon Society Education Scholarship

The scholarship will be awarded annually to a student with permanent residency in Ashtabula, Geauga, or Lake counties of Ohio. The award is \$1,000 towards tuition and fees. The student must be a graduating high school senior or current college student who wishes to pursue a degree in Environmental studies, Ornithology, Forestry, Wildlife Biology, Sustainable Agriculture, or related fields. Such studies should align with Blackbrook' mission statement "To promote conservation and restoration of ecosystems with emphasis on birds and habitats through education and advocacy within Ohio's Ashtabula, Lake and Geauga counties."

Selection will be based on the quality of application responses, academic history, letters of recommendation, and evidence of interest in the chosen field through community involvement and activities. (Examples could include Science Olympiad, Young Birders club, camps, scout projects with focus on wildlife or forest restoration, or other related activities.)

The award amount of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) will be granted for tuition and fees only. A check will be issued to the recipient's school directly, in July /August for use in the fall semester of the same calendar year. This check will be provided upon receiving a copy of the recipient's class registration for fall semester. The student is responsible for providing all account information and student ID number to our treasurer, for purposes of funds disbursement.

Eligibility requirements: applicants seeking an associate or bachelor's degree must also:

- Be a permanent resident of Ashtabula, Geauga or Lake County.
- Submit documentation of college acceptance/enrollment
- Have a transcript showing a minimum 3.00 GPA
- Provide record of community environmental activities
- Provide a statement of intent to complete the chosen degree program in an above-mentioned field of study

Application requirements

- Complete the scholarship application and provide all required supporting documentation by May 1
- Official high school and/or college transcript
- List of activities and/or organization involvement
- Two letters of recommendations from instructors, community leaders or employer to be mailed directly to: Blackbrook Audubon Society, P.O. Box 1306, Mentor, Ohio 44061-1306

The scholarship committee will contact the recipient via letter no later than June 30. The recipient will be acknowledged at the September program of the Blackbrook Audubon Society.

The Blackbrook Audubon Society Education Scholarship recipient shall be selected solely on the basis of merit without any consideration of race, ethnicity, sexual preference or religious affiliation.
