Dear Griffin Family,

Welcome to McGarvey for the 2025-26 school year! We're glad you're part of our Griffin family!

McGarvey follows a year-round calendar with 4 different tracks. You can find the calendar for the 2025-26 school year on the district website at http://egusd.net.

In grades 1-6, school starts at 9:05 and ends at 3:35 – except on Thursdays and track-change days. Every Thursday is earlyout and dismissal is at 2:45. Track-change days occur about once a month and dismissal is at 1:35.

Due to staffing assignments for the new school year, your child may have been moved to McGarvey and/or onto a new track. Students are assigned to schools and tracks based on available space and the date students were registered.

As of this date, your child's grade level and track assignment have been communicated by email. In early July we will communicate again with the name of your child's teacher.

Enrollment at McGarvey is increasing substantially in 2025-26. Many of our new students come from outside our attendance area, and nearly 300 students will be in TK or Kindergarten. To ease the traffic around the school at arrival and dismissal times, we encourage our neighborhood families to walk or bike to school. Let's work together to reserve car traffic for those families who live farther away and for our littlest Griffins. Please look for more information coming soon about Walk & Bike Trains and consider volunteering to lead a walking or biking caravan to/from school.

Mello-Roos Tax Reduction offered for Senior Citizens & Disabled Persons

Senior citizens and disabled persons can apply for a special tax reduction through June 30, 2025. Between April 15 and June 30, senior citizens age 65 or older; or fully disabled persons living within the Elk Grove Unified School District boundary may apply for a 70 percent reduction in their Mello-Roos tax assessment (direct levy #0155).
