Earning Your Diploma

To Earn Your Diploma You Must:

- Complete a minimum of 220 credits (Seniors should have at least 160 credits)
- Pass 12th grade English course (ex: AP Lit, English IV)
- Pass 12th grade Social Science course (ex: AP Econ, AP Gov Gov/Econ)
- Complete any graduation requirements that have not yet been fulfilled (ex: electives)

If a student doesn't complete the above requirements , they will not receive their diploma in June and will not participate in the graduation commencement ceremony.



 - Fee waiver available based on eligibility
- CSU <u>does not require</u> letters of recommendation
- No college essay!!

UC - University of California

www.californiacolleges.edu

Submit App: October 1 - December 1

- Application Fee: \$80.00 per campus
 - Fee waiver available based on eligibility
- UC <u>does not require</u> letters of recommendation
- UC requires completion of four Personal Insight Questions.

Benefits for attending a Community College

- Only requirement to enroll in a Community College is a high school diploma
- Transfer programs to Four Year Universities
- TAG Programs (Transfer Admission Guarantee)
- Certificate Programs (2 or 3 semesters to complete)
- Tuition is significantly less than a Four Year University
- Promise Program (free!)



- Nov 1-15 early decision/action deadline for some colleges
- Work on all college applications and essays
- · Deadline to pay for AP exams
- Ask for college app and financial aid support. Attend workshops

- Deadline to submit applications for
- some private/out of state colleges
 Jan 15th, deadline to apply for EOP at Cal States
- Create college portals to view updates & check your emails
- Complete FAFSA/CADAA

- Complete housing application
- May 1 Deadline to accept admission for UC & CSU

Course Descriptions

BUS 1 INTRODUCTION TO BUSINESS

3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers; CSU, UC

Business concepts and practices; develops knowledge, thinking skills, and related business skills with regard to forms of ownership, management, finance, marketing, production, competition, technologies, global business, entrepreneurship, legal considerations, controls through which business organizations operate and other aspects of business.

BUS 125- HUMAN RELATIONS IN BUSINESS 3.0 Units/3 hours lecture, Transfers: CSU

Development of effective human relations in business organizations. Learn how to work effectively with colleagues and customers. Develop confidence, positive relationships, and leadership skills through effective communicating, motivating, team building skills, project management, and conflict resolution.

CIMP 8A PROGRAMMING WITH PYTHON

3.0 Units 2.00 hours Lecture 3.00 hours Lab. Transfers: CSU, UC

Introductory programming course teaching standard algorithmic programming concepts using the Python programming language. Class covers syntax, variables, strings, conditions, flow control structures loops, switches, classes, database connections, utilities, short-circuit evaluations and frameworks. Class also covers data structures using sets, frozen sets, lists, arrays and dictionaries. No prior coding experience necessary. Class includes many python programming assignments and one large programming project. 25 hours of online instruction in addition to in-person class meetings.

MUS 28 HISTORY OF ROCK

3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers; CSU, UC

A study of the elements of rock music tracing the development and evolution of its styles and structures, including sociological and political aspects, from rock's beginning to the present time.

HSC 104 MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY

3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers; CSU

Application and orientation to medical terminology, basic structure of medical terms and their components—roots, prefixes, suffixes and combining forms. Emphasizes analysis, meaning, spelling and pronunciation to building a medical vocabulary applicable to the specialties of medicine, major diseases and terms used on physical examination, diagnosis and treatment.




Official and Unofficial Transcript

<u>Unofficial</u> <u>Transcripts</u>

- All courses are self-reported so please use your Aeries portal/printed transcript to report grades
- Available in your Student Portal

Official Transcripts

- Private/Out of State Universities may require an official transcript as part of the application process.
- Must be ordered online through PARCHMENT.

Matriculation

• Once you commit to a university (CSU, UC, private, out of state) you will be asked to send your final official transcript which includes your graduation date **PLEASE order your** transcript online through PARCHMENT by June 5, 2026



Letter of Recommendation

Do You Need a LETTER Written by a Counselor?

- Some private or out of state public schools require at least one letter of recommendation written by a counselor
- Your counselor will complete the <u>Secondary School</u> <u>Report or Counselor's Report</u> if the college requires one and the student requests them.



Letter of Recommendation

- Go to the <u>Guidance</u> tab and select <u>College</u> <u>Information</u>
 - Select Letter of Recommendation Packet

• Academic/Teacher Letters

- Ask a teacher in person that you feel knows you the best and can speak to who you are as a student.
- Contact the teacher as early as possible.
- Do not wait until the last minute
- Be sure to THANK them. Teachers write the letters on their own time.

- Application Opens Oct. 1st and California deadline is March 2, 2026

College Campus Based Aid

- Must file FAFSA and <u>CSS Profile</u> (for some universities) to be considered.
 Check the financial aid page on the website of the college/university you
- are applying to.
 Adhere to deadlines as they will be different and sometimes earlier than the admissions deadline!!

Cal Grants For California Schools

- Information at <u>www.calgrants.org</u>
- All student GPA's will be sent to the California Aid Commission to determine **Grant GPA eligibility**
- California State deadline: March 2, 2026

California Dream Act

- Can apply Oct 1, 2025
- Must meet AB 540 requirements



Scholarships

- Current list on the website and send information via Canvas announcements- LINK
- Students are responsible for researching and applying to scholarships on their own. Start Early!!!!!
- Follow deadlines and instructions for completing scholarship applications.
- Apply to as many as possible.

Are Senior Classes **Important?**

- UC and CSU do care about performance senior year acceptance could be rescinded if grades go down.
- Private Schools ask counselors for reports as the year goes on. Any changes could change their admission decisions.
- Change status in NHS and CSF
- End of the year awards (Up to the Spring 12 week grade reporting period)
 - Scholar of Scholars

 - Valedictorian (GPA 4.0 +) Academic Distinction (GPA 3.5 3.99)
