## INCLEMENT WEATHER NOTICE

## Dear Parents,

During inclement weather, the Pioneer Union School District will notify all parents of any changes to the bell schedule, such as a two-hour delay or snow day, through automated phone calls and Parent Square. Additionally, we will request that local television and radio stations share these updates with their audiences.

On days when a storm hits too late to adjust bell schedules, school buses will still run their routes as safely as possible. However, due to road conditions, buses may operate at slower speeds.

For your child's safety, we understand that it is ultimately your decision whether to allow them to ride the bus to school or how long to wait at the bus stop.

If you have recently updated your phone number(s) or email address, please notify the school office as soon as possible. Keeping your contact information up to date ensures you receive our automated calls and important notifications.

RED route may not provide service to some of its school bus stops when snow is present, but will provide service to satellite stops that are listed below for the upper Grizzly Flat/Grizzly Park areas in place of the regular daily route stop.

You may use one of the following stops listed below:
