Course Description:

The leadership class will be responsible for scheduling and running virtually all of the activities at the school that are ASB based. The students will learn about teamwork, finances, recordkeeping, community involvement, and technology. The students will set up and run the dances, rallies, assemblies, spirit weeks/days and work on campus improvement projects. The class will be responsible for maintaining and spending the ASB budget. The students will vote on all of the purchase orders that are requested by teachers and staff. Students will also participate in conversations based on life experiences and mental health to practice empathy, supporting others and personal growth and healing.

Leadership is a valuable experience in team building, communication, cooperation and obviously leadership qualities. Students in leadership are the face of our school and are expected to uphold a prime example of an outstanding student at Marsh on a daily basis.

Grading Policy:

My grading policy is based on a straight percentage basis. The grades are as follows:
90-100%: A 80-89%: B 70-79%:C 60-69%:D Below 60 %:F

The majority of the work in this class will be as follows

- 10 Points weekly for in class work responsibilities
- 20 Hours of community service each semester (10 points per hour)
- Team/Self Evaluations
- Misc. Classwork/Homework assignments

Classroom Behavior Modification Policy:

Tardies/Absences: You are tardy if you are not in your seat when the bell rings. Students can be removed from leadership for issues with excessive tardies. A big part of leadership is being here on a regular basis. Excessive absences may result in a discussion about improving attendance or finding an elective that is a better fit due to low attendance.

Discipline: As leadership students, we should not have any discipline problems. However, should the occasion arise where a student is causing discipline problems in my class or ANY other class, I reserve the right to remove them from Leadership. Students may be put on a probation/improvement plan for behavior or grades. Students will only receive one opportunity at probation per year.

Other Grounds for Removal: Should a situation arise where a student is unable to meet the expectations of a leadership student, I will hold a meeting with Mrs. Kamph or Mrs. Deluna, the student and myself where we will develop a plan for improvement. If the plan is not met in the set time frame, the student may be removed from the class. Any student who earns an F or lower than a 2.5 GPA on a report card/progress report will have until the next quarter/semester grading window to improve the grade. If the grade is not improved, the student may be removed from the class.

Be in your seat with your materials on your desk when the bell rings.

Respect the rights of others.

Show respect for the classroom materials and equipment.

Stay on task and follow directions.

Cursing will not be tolerated.
