CITY OF CHICO OFFERS FREE 2-HOUR PARKING ON FRIDAYS IN DOWNTOWN FOR THE HOLIDAYS

CHICO, CA — In alignment with City Council's direction to staff, the City of Chico is pleased to announce annual free 2-hour parking on Fridays in the downtown area beginning this holiday season! November 21st to December 26th, visitors can enjoy free 2-hour parking on Fridays from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. in designated downtown areas as they shop, dine, and experience local events.

Key Details:

- Free 2-hour parking will be available on Fridays only, once per day.
- Visitors who park in the 2-hour zones downtown do not need to pay; time limits will be enforced.
- For the long-term zones in downtown, the first 2 hours will be free. Payment will be required for additional time, allowing for an extended stay.

To support turnover and ensure parking is available to all visitors, **time limits will be enforced.** For shoppers and visitors utilizing long-term parking, simply pay at the kiosks to access free 2-hour parking or use the Passport app. Downtown employees are encouraged to use city parking lots and the parking garage for long-term parking during this period, making additional on-street spaces available for customers and guests.

To help visitors plan accordingly, please refer to the attached map for details on designated parking zones included in the Friday free 2-hour holiday parking program. The City of Chico wishes everyone a safe and joyful holiday season and appreciates your cooperation.
