- Create your FSA ID - <https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch>
 - The FSA ID is your username and password combination that you will use every year you fill out the FAFSA.
 - You will need your Social Security number, full name, date of birth, and email address (not school email).
 - Each parent/guardian with a Social Security Number will also need to create their own FSA ID.
- Starting in **October 2025**, launch your **2026-2027** FAFSA (FREE Application for Federal Student Aid) **OR** CADAA (California Dream Act App) through www.CaliforniaColleges.edu
