Dear Parent/Guardian,

We're introducing a new way to make everyday school routines faster, safer, and easier for your child.

The **HI-5 Wave Scanner** is a multi-use unit that will now allow a touch-free system for students to check in and out. You may still utilize it as a pin pad (PINs entered manually).

What is the HI-5?™

A fast, contactless way for students to check in at school locations.

How does this feature work?

Students simply wave their hand above the scanner. The system detects a unique wave pattern in the hand using safe, touch-free technology and converts it into a secure, encrypted code.



Is my child's information safe?

Yes. This system is designed with strong security safeguards, and personal data is protected. No photos or images are collected or stored.

Where is the HI-5™ used?

It may be used in school cafeterias, libraries, and other approved school locations.

Is participation required?

No. Students can opt out and use a PIN or barcode scanner on this device.



How does my child enroll?

Enrollment is quick and simple. Your child briefly holds their hand above the scanner, and the system creates a secure encrypted identifier for future use.

How does this feature benefit students and families?

- Shorter lines mean more time for students to eat and relax.
- No ID cards to be lost, stolen, or hacked.
- Reduced administrative costs allow schools to focus more resources on student programs.
- A safer, more convenient daily experience for students.
