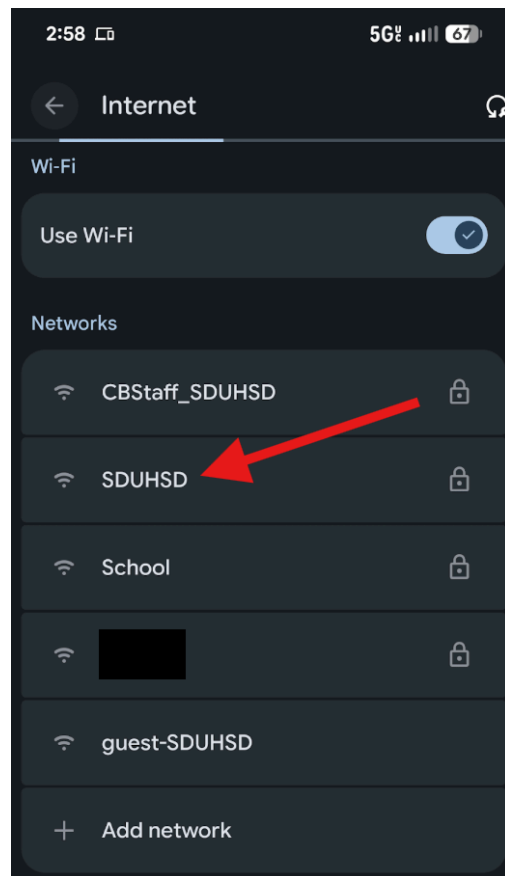


Connecting an Android device to SDUHSD Wifi

Step 1: Open Wifi Settings

Choose the network "SDUHSD"



Step 2: Enter the following settings

- Set "EAP method" to "PEAP"
- Set "Phase 2 authentication" to "MSCHAPV2"
- Set "CA Certificate" to "Trust on First Use" or "Do not validate"
- Set "Anonymous identity" to be blank
- Under "Identity" enter your district username:

Staff:
firstname.lastname

Students:
last name + first initial + last 4 digits of permanent ID

Note: do not include [@sduhsd.net](mailto:sduhsd.net) or [@my.sduhsd.net](mailto:my.sduhsd.net) at the end of your username!

Then tap "Connect"
