 - Ideas for student involvement in promoting school meals among peers.
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
2. Review of the School Meals Survey that went out to all CMS students

How often do you eat a school provided meal (breakfast or lunch)?

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

Overall, how satisfied are you with the school meals?

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

What is the **primary reason** you choose to eat school meals?

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

For those that do not consume school meals, what are the **primary reasons** you choose **NOT** to eat school meals? **please select TWO responses*

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

How would you rate the taste of the food?

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

How would you rate the freshness of ingredients?

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

3. Areas for Improvement Based on Survey Results

Students provided feedback and suggestions:

- Ensure food is served at an appropriate temperature; some items were reported as not hot enough.
- Offer a wider variety of beverages (additional juice and milk flavors).
- Improve speed of service to reduce waiting times.
- Address soggy hot foods; improve quality of items held for extended periods.
- Rotate menus more frequently.
- Enhance quality of fruits and vegetables on the salad bar (issues with overripe/underripe produce).

- Pre-package or cup more salad bar items to reduce contamination.
 - Place lids on exposed items (e.g., parfait cups, chia pudding cups).
 - Conduct more frequent taste tests for new menu items to gather accurate feedback.
 - Continue meal surveys throughout the school year to track improvements and outcomes.
 - Feature student-favorite items more prominently.
