CCSPP At a Glance

The Full-Service California Community Schools Partnership Program (CCSPP) supports schools' efforts to partner and align community resources to improve student outcomes. These partnerships provide an integrated focus on academics, health and social services, youth and community development, and family/community engagement.

Golden Hills was awarded the CCSPP Implementation grant 2024-25 school year. The grant is a 5-year grant. Golden Hills has just completed the first year of implementation.



Goal 1

Mental Health Screening and Services

- **All students are screened for mental health and wellness support.**
- **Referrals are made for students who need access to support resources.**
- **A full time Mental Health and Wellness Clinician is available to students on campus**



Goal 2

During School Learning Pathways For All Students

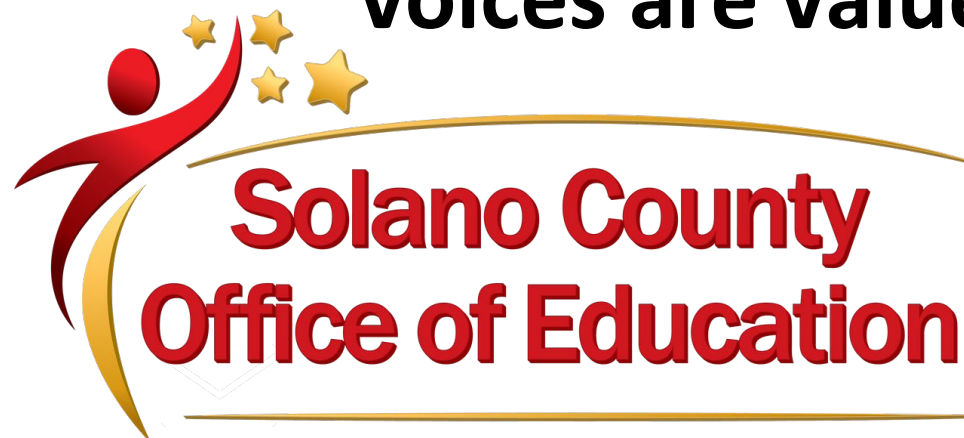
- **Individual Learning Plans (ILP) are created for each student to identify their specific learning and career goals.**
- **Career Technical Education is offered - Introduction to Construction Trades and Introduction to Cosmetology, etc.**



GOAL 3

Shared Decision Making- Students, Parents, and Community Members

- **Monthly Community School Partnership Meetings**
- **Surveys – In-person or online**
- **Drop in visits to share ideas**
- **Front Porch discussions - Parents and community members can share their recommendations from the porch if their schedules do not permit in-person visits.**
- **Students, parents, staff, and community members participate in the meetings to ensure that all voices are valued and heard.**
