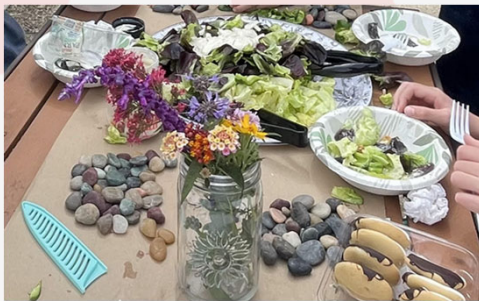
# Garden Club

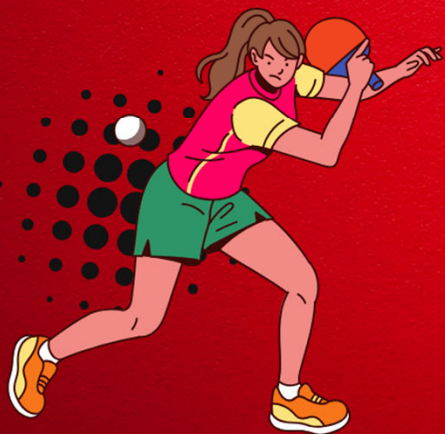


