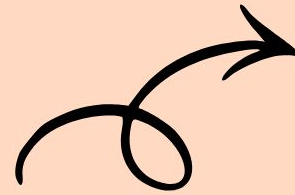

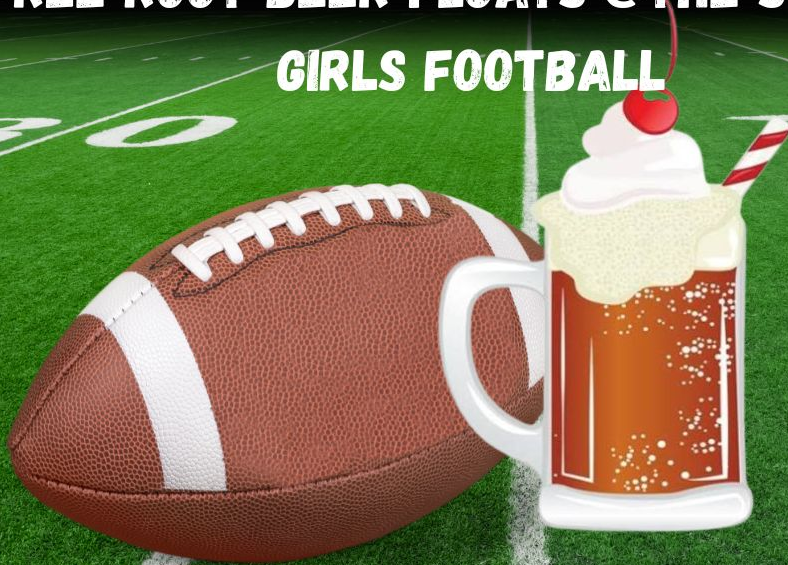

Daily Bulletin Theme Solving Contest

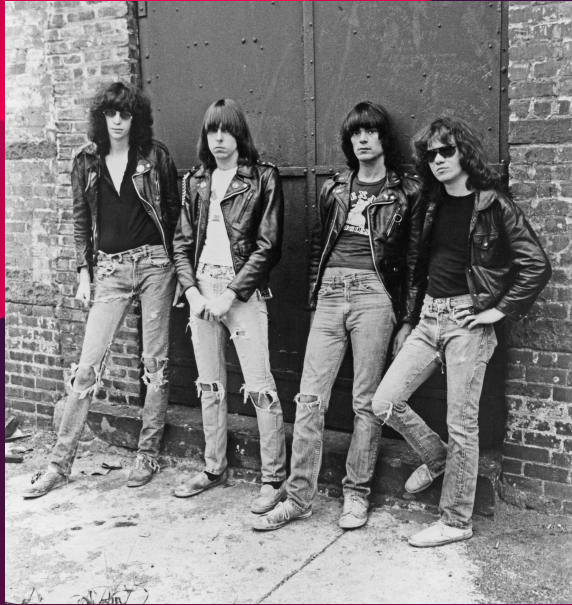
