- I. Call to Order**

- IV. Old Business Items**
 - a. Tutoring**
No Cap on the total number of students that can be served. Groups are generally no bigger than 10 to 15. Currently, 3 teachers are tutoring (2 DI, 1 Eo). We need more teachers to service students. Afterschool tutoring works well with Spark students who complete their tutoring, and then go to Spark.
