SCSOS: Mr. Sherrod shared he met with CTA, they are not close to settling. CSEA is close to settling.

VII. Program Update (Information) Ms. Franklin, Ms. Osumi 9:00am

SCSOS: Ms. Franklin reported referrals are increasing. SCSOS is planning for ESY. They are focusing on training Paraeducators.

YCUSD: Ms. Davit shared they are planning for ESY, making projections for next year.

VIII. Local Plan Governance Proposal (Action) Dr. Morgan 9:02am

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Dr. Morgan asked to decide on taking Operations Council out of the Brown Act.

Ms. Jolly made a motion to approve taking Operations Council out from under the Brown Act. Ms. Shelton seconded the motion. Motion was carried unanimously.

IX. Behavior Oriented County Classroom Update (Discussion) Dr. Morgan 9:02am

Dr. Morgan shared he, Ms. Franklin, and Mr. Houston are meeting today with Boy's Town for Behavioral Classroom ideas.

X. NPS Update (Discussion) Dr. Morgan 9:03am

Rising Star has hired 8 teachers already for the new NPS at Central Gaither. We are waiting for the lease, so we can get started on renovations.

XI. MTU Update (Action) Dr. Morgan 9:04am

We were able to get two classrooms at FRA, to house the MTU. Dr. Morgan is asking for support and provide with awareness, asking for \$100,000 for rent, and for equipment. Ms. Shelton moved to use Medi-Cal funds for the MTU, Mr. Meyers seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

XII. Proposal to Expand Medi-Cal Reimbursable Activities (Action) Dr. Morgan 9:06am

XIII. Registered Behavior Technician Training (Action) Dr. Morgan 9:12am

Dr. Morgan is proposing to use Medi-Cal dollars to send IAs to training. The estimated cost is \$50,000 for 30 participants. The training is self-paced, 40 hours, and they have 180 days to complete it. Ms. Jolly made a motion to approve supporting the training, Mr. Gulbrandsen seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

XIV. Assistive Technology Training (Information) Dr. Morgan 9:18am

Dr. Morgan shared about the Assistive Technology training program through Cal State Northridge. This would be helpful for SPED teachers, COTAs, SLPs, etc. It

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is a 100 hour training. \$25,000 for 10 professionals. Mr. Gulbrandsen made a motion to support using Medi-Cal funds for the training, and Ms. Shelton seconded the motion.
