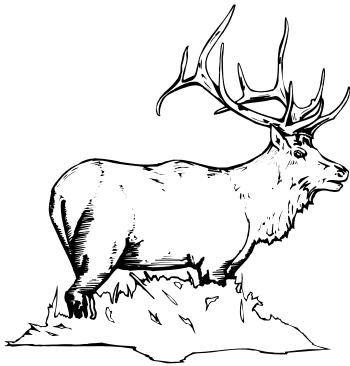

Addressing Academic Learning Loss: *Anticipated Expenditures (\$276,000)*

- Accelerated instruction and support services for students embedded throughout the school day to address learning gaps
- Online curriculum and technology supports for students to address learning gaps

Health, Safety, and Infrastructure:

- Addition of a Technology Assistant to support technology infrastructure and manage additional devices for students and staff

Student Services Support:

- Employment of 2 certified counselors to address academic, social, emotional and mental health needs of all students
