

Class Description: This is a year-long class that focuses on producing the MJHS yearbook. Graphic design and photography are a large part of this class. Students must be willing to take pictures at a variety of school events and take responsibility for their assigned portion of the yearbook. Other published projects will also be produced throughout the year.

Class Rules:

1. Be on time! That means in your seat/signed in and ready to work.
2. Be respectful of others and the computer equipment. Do not touch other student's computers.
3. Be on task and use time wisely!
4. No food or drinks near the computers in class! Water bottles are okay!
5. Other expectations will be discussed throughout the year.

Classwork Policy: In order for students to succeed in this class, they will need to be present daily and ready to make good use of class time. Most assignments will be posted on Google Classroom or eDesign. There will be due dates posted with the assignments to help students stay on track, but I will accept Google Classroom work late for credit from within the same grading period.
