Please refrain from scheduling appointments, late arrival, and/or early dismissal during your child's testing dates if possible. We do provide make-up assessment sessions for students when they are ill or unable to attend due to an emergency.

Parent/guardian request for exemption:

In accordance with policy IKA, the parent/guardian of a student enrolled in RMSEL may request that his or her child be exempt from participating in one or more state assessments.

- 1) The request for exemption must be submitted in writing to Lindsay Emery District Assessment Coordinator.
- 2) The parent/guardian will not be required to state the reason for asking for the exemption.
- 3) The request for exemption may apply to all or specific

state assessments administered to the student during the school year.

- 4) A request for exemption will be valid for one school year. Requests for exemption from state assessments in subsequent school years require a new written request.
- 5) Parents/guardians are required to submit their requests for exemption two weeks prior to an assessment window to access an alternative educational activity on campus.

Medication Deadline

In order to have adequate time for preparation of student medications and paperwork for crew trips, the following deadlines have been established for turning in medications for trips to the office. Please remember that all medication



requires a completed and signed (by the physician) medication form. Medication must be in the **original**, **labeled container**, **with the student's name**, **dosage instructions**, **and expiration date**. Medications cannot be accepted after the stated deadline.

Passage Panels: Celebrating Our Students

Each year, RMSEL students in grades 3, 5, 8, 10, and 12 participate in a portfolio review and passage panel process. It takes 110 volunteers plus 30 staff members to create this authentic experience and celebrate students. We are still in need of 50 volunteers to participate on panels and engage with students.

Passage panels are a two-day commitment: a Portfolio Reading Day paired with a Portfolio Presentation Day. Below is the schedule for this year's process:

- Wed May 21: Presentation Day for grades 3, 5
- Thur May 22: Presentation Day for grades 8, 10

Clothing Donation Bin at RMSEL

85% of textile waste ends up in landfills occupying unnecessary landfill space, which equates to an astounding 22+ BILLION POUNDS of unnecessary dumping of clothes, shoes, and textiles into landfills each year. The Clothes Bin® Textile Recycling program offers schools and organizations an opportunity to increase educational awareness of textile recycling, convenience to students, parents, and neighbors who have materials they will not use, and raises money for our school.

You can donate textiles (sheets, blankets, clothes, backpacks, jackets, stuffed animals, shoes, tablecloths, towels, purses, bags, etc.) Items should be bagged and dropped in our clothes bin located near the front of the building. RMSEL receives \$1 per pound of clothes donated. In February our community donated 25 bags with a return of \$21.16 to RMSEL.
