School Calendar

School is open from mid-August to the end of May. We take the same breaks and holidays as Corning Union High School District. Other than CTE courses, students may start and stop courses at any time during the year. School calendars are available upon request.

School Policies

Attendance

Regular attendance is essential for success.

- A minimum of 12 hours is required to complete any course.
- CTE courses require 95% attendance rate in order for students to learn all skills and information required.
 - Students with excessive absences may be dropped from the course.
- Students who are enrolled in a course to fulfill a requirement for an outside agency may have specific attendance. Please refer to your agency's guidelines for more information.
