

Orland High School Parental Involvement Policy

I General Expectations

Orland High School agrees to implement the following statutory requirements:

8. Orland High School will provide parents of participating children if requested by parents, opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of their children, and respond to any such suggestions as soon as practicably possible.

9. Orland High School will submit to the district any parent comments if the schoolwide plan under section (1114) (b)(2) is not satisfactory to parents of participating children.

III Shared responsibilities for high student academic achievement

Orland High School will build the schools' and parents' capacity for strong parental involvement. To ensure the effective involvement of parents and to support a partnership among the school, parents, and the community, the following activities will occur:

- Send letters home
- Provide bilingual translation
- Use of the auto dialer
 - Use of Parent Square through Aeries Communications to email and autodial messages from the school to the community

2. The school will incorporate the school-parent compact as a component of its School Parental Involvement Policy.

3. The school will, with the assistance of its district, assist parents of children served by the school in understanding topics such as the following, by undertaking the actions described in this paragraph --

- the State's academic content standards,
- the State's student academic achievement standards,
- the State and local academic assessments including alternate assessments,
- how to monitor their child's progress, and
- how to work with educators
