

2026-27 Saturday School Attendance Recovery

What is Attendance Recovery?

Students have the opportunity to recover classroom time lost due to absences during a four-hour Saturday session.

Who Can Attend?

Any student who has missed school due to an excused or unexcused absence may earn credit during the Saturday sessions. Only absences are recoverable at the Saturday sessions.

How Do I Sign Up?

There is no need to sign up. See below for where/when to report.

Where Do I Report For Saturday School?

Students report to the OHS Career Center on the assigned Saturday. The session promptly begins at 8am and ends at 12pm. Doors are locked at 8:05 A.M with no late admittance. If a student leaves the session early, they will not receive any attendance recovery credit.

What Do I Need To Bring With Me?

Students must bring at least 4 hours' worth of school work or reading materials. This includes class assignments, textbooks, and projects. Students may also work on any needed credit recovery during this time.

What Are The Rules I Need To Follow?

1. All school rules are in effect, and students are expected to display behavior in accordance with the student code of conduct.
2. Students may not eat, talk, or sleep during the Saturday session or they will be asked to leave. If a student is asked to leave the Saturday session, he/she will not receive any attendance recovery credit for that Saturday. Partial credit is not awarded.
3. Cell phones, music players, and all other electronic equipment is not allowed during the Saturday session. Per school policy, the electronic device will be confiscated until the end of the Saturday session.
4. If a student leaves Saturday School early without notifying the teacher in charge, that student will no longer have the opportunity to attend future Saturday School sessions for the year.
