My student and I further understand that my student must abide by all rules and regulations set by the School Board for the Nevada Joint Union High School District, the school and the trip chaperones. If any of the school rules, field trip rules, or district rules are broken, the participant will be held accountable and will be sent home at his or her expense.

Some of the rules and regulations, (but not limited to the following) which are to be adhered to by your student at all times while on the trip:

- Alcohol and Drugs: Absolutely no alcohol or drug use will be tolerated under any circumstances during the trip activity. Alcohol and controlled substances are illegal and are not permitted at any time during any school-sponsored activity. If your student is found under the influence, or if your student is in possession of alcohol or drugs, your student will be immediately expelled from the activity. The chaperones will write your student's referral when they return to school. The consequences will follow the Nevada Joint Union High School District & Board Policy.
- o Participants must stay with the group at all times.
- <u>Unacceptable conduct:</u> Rowdiness, fighting, damaging property, foul language, any illegal act including shoplifting or stealing, and not following chaperones' rules. Again, the consequences and punishment will be the same as outlined in the student handbook which can be found on-line.
