Dear 4th – 8th Grade Parent or Guardian,

Next week, Cottonwood Creek Charter School will be asking students in grades 4-8 to participate in the Cottonwood Creek Student Survey. This is a very important survey that helps promote better health and well-being among our youth, improve the school learning environment and better equip our school to combat problems such as drug abuse and violence. The survey results give us valuable information about students’ attitudes and behaviors. We use this information to develop better ways to help students become healthier, happier, and more successful in school and life.

Survey Content: The survey gathers information on developmental supports provided to youth; school connectedness and barriers to learning; school safety; health-related concerns such as physical activity and nutritional habits; alcohol, tobacco and other drug use.

You can see a copy of the survey at the front office or view it at our website cottonwoodcreekcharter.com under the School Docs tab.

It is Voluntary: Your student is not required to take the survey. If you do not want your student to complete the survey, you must notify the school. Students that do participate do not have to answer any questions they do not want to answer and may stop taking the survey at any time.

It is Anonymous: Students do not put their names on the survey. There is no way for the school or anyone else to know how a particular student has answered the survey questions.

Administration: The student survey is completed online and will be administered between May 27-29 in your student’s class. It should take about 5-10 minutes to complete.

If you do not want your student to participate, please complete the section below and return it to your student’s teacher by Thursday, May 21.
