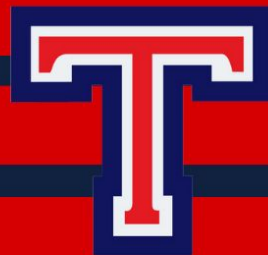

Academic Program

College Prep Courses

- All students start on a college prep track

Honors Courses

- Wide variety of honors courses offered each year.
- Honors courses provide a higher level of rigor (Higher levels of thinking, stronger reading and writing skills)
- Adds an additional point to their GPA calculation

AP Courses

- 28 AP courses offered for the 2026-2027 year - (most offered in CUSD)
- College credit with passage of National AP Exams in May.

Saddleback College Courses

- Earn high school and college credit



College & Career Advantage



- CCA offers Career Technical Education (CTE) courses are hands on classes that prepare you for college and careers. (Used to be ROP)
- Internship opportunities with select classes.
- Offered both during and after school.
- Often taught by professionals in the respective career fields.

CTE Pathways

Consecutive CTE courses in a common field creates a pathway.

Pathways available on campus during the school day :

- Design, Visual, and Media Arts
- Performing Arts
- Business/Entrepreneurship
- Sports Medicine
- Environmental Resources and Sustainability
- Teaching/Education

Additional pathways are available through after school courses.

- Socially there is more to do; Time management is important

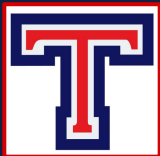

Athletic Program

3 Seasons of Sport - Typically a maximum of one sport per season.

Fall - Cross Country, Football, Girls Flag Football, Surfing, Girls Golf, Girls Tennis, Girls Volleyball, Boys Water Polo, Pep Squad (Year round)

Winter - Basketball, Soccer, Wrestling, Girls Water Polo

Spring - Baseball, Lacrosse, Swimming, Softball, Track and Field, Boys Golf, Boys Tennis, Boys Volleyball, Girls Beach Volleyball

- 30% of students attend 2-year college

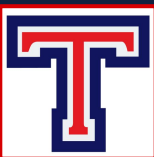
AP Program - #1 in CUSD

How can my student attend Tesoro?

- If my child currently attends a CUSD school and lives in Tesoro's attendance boundary.
- Attending Ladera Ranch, Las Flores, Arroyo Vista, Esencia ; you are automatically enrolled - do nothing.



How can my student attend Tesoro?

If your Student currently attends a CUSD school and lives outside of our attendance boundary.

- You will need to complete a School of Choice application
 - Application available on CUSD website (January 5th - February 1st)
- Complete course registration process at your home school now
- Once approved, all of the students information is moved to Tesoro.

Decision becomes binding upon confirmation in March.

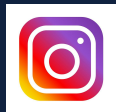
