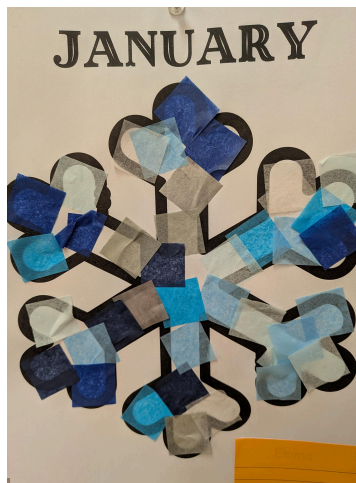

Mobile Communication Device Policy Reminder













Effective August 2025: SRVUSD's new district-wide policy regarding [student use of cell phones and other mobile communication devices](#) (MCDs) during the school day.

Students' devices should be kept in their backpack if they are brought to school. Sycamore is not responsible for lost or misplaced devices.

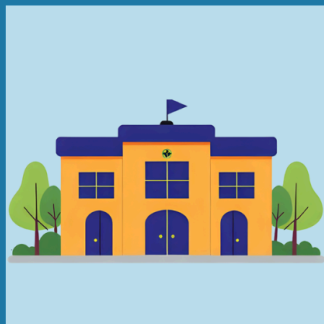

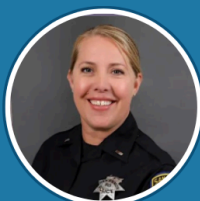

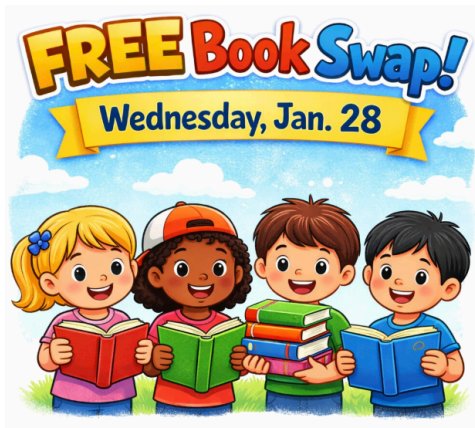

We ask all of our parents/guardians to register w/ Be A Mentor for level #1 - general volunteer. This clearance will allow you to be on campus and/or in the classroom with the children. Can my child purchase a second meal?

Yes, but they need to have funds on their prepayment account, which can be done on the Titan [Family Portal](#). Cash will not be accepted in the breakfast or lunch line. Cash or checks can be given to the Child Nutrition Manager outside of the breakfast or lunch meal service time. A second breakfast is \$4.00 and a second lunch is \$5.75 at Elementary Schools and \$6.00 at Middle and High Schools. School staff can purchase a breakfast for \$4.50 and lunch for \$6.00.
