The Del Mar Union School District (DMUSD) Board of Trustees approved the appointment of DeWayne Cossey as chief technology officer at its March 11 board meeting.

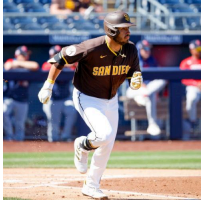

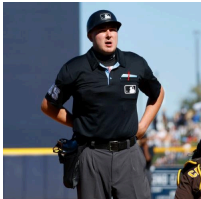

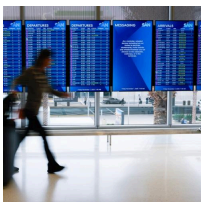
