

River City High School Football Game Fan Expectations

Dear Parents, Guardians, and RCHS Community,

As we welcome everyone to upcoming River City High School football games, our top priority is providing a safe, positive experience for all attendees. Please review the following updated policies and expectations to ensure your visit is enjoyable and secure.

Metal Detector Screening:

- Handheld metal detectors will be used at stadium entrances for all home football games.
- Every attendee must participate in the screening to enter.
- Individuals who refuse the screening or do not pass will be denied entry and asked to leave.
- If a person refuses to leave after being denied, law enforcement may be contacted.
- Metal detectors are safe for medical devices (e.g., pacemakers, insulin pumps). Those needing assistance should inform security staff upon arrival.

Bag and Drink Policy:

- Only clear bags sized up to 5 x 8 inches are allowed inside the stadium; all bags will be inspected.
- Non-clear bags are allowed only for medical or essential reasons and will be inspected.
- Drinks must be factory-sealed and non-alcoholic. Reusable bottles must be empty before entry.

Behavior Expectations and Re-Entry:

- Re-entry is not permitted; if you leave the stadium, you cannot return that day.
Fighting, disruptive actions, or refusal to follow rules will result in immediate removal.
- Staff will report incidents and law enforcement will intervene if necessary.
- Let's work together to cheer respectfully, show school spirit, and enjoy supporting our student-athletes.

Thank you for partnering with River City High School to maintain a safe and welcoming environment for our students and community. As part of our safety efforts, the West Sacramento Police Department will be present at every game, working alongside staff to support a positive experience for all. Go Raiders!
