

OUR MISSION

IS TO TRANSFORM OUR TRADITIONAL PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM INTO A COMMUNITY HUB THAT PROVIDES COMPREHENSIVE, INTEGRATED SUPPORT SYSTEMS FOR STUDENTS, FAMILIES AND STAFF. WE WILL PRIORITIZE COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, ADDRESSING THE NEEDS OF THE WHOLE CHILD, AND FOSTERING A SENSE OF BELONGING AND EQUITY.

THE POSITIVE IMPACT

- OUR WELLNESS CENTER DOORS HAVE OPENED OVER 6400 TIMES TO SUPPORT STUDENTS.
- 57 REFERRALS HAVE COME THROUGH AND 31 OF THOSE ARE CURRENTLY RECEIVING THERAPY
- OVER 65 STUDENTS ARE ENROLLED IN ENRICHMENT CLUBS/CLASSES AFTER SCHOOL
- 500 FAMILIES WERE PROVIDED FOOD THROUGH COLLABORATION WITH THE YUBA SUTTER FOOD BANK

THE FOUR PILLARS

- Integrated Student Supports: On site we have 3 counselors, Warrior Wellness Center has 1 full time social worker and a part time therapist, Community Schools Coordinator and an Outreach Consultant
- Expanded and Enriched Learning Time & Opportunities: We offer after schools clubs/classes: Tutoring 2x week in 2 classrooms, Robotics, Martial Arts, Girls on the Run, Soccer Club and Art Club
- Active Family & Community Engagement: We have monthly food distribution, ELAC meetings and campus visits from LHS JROTC program. We partnered with So You Can to provide families with Christmas dinners and presents for kids. We have had field trips to colleges. Once a week we have a positive community member visit during lunches to spread kindness and hope. We partnered with YCOE and hosted Friday Night Kickback events.
- Collaborative Leadership & Practices: Our teachers have weekly PLC meetings. We also have a weekly case consult meeting with the counselors and our wellness center. Our Community Schools Advisory Council, School Site Council and ELAC meetings are held monthly.
